



Features Cherry's Chalk Texture collection for Contempo Studio of Benartex

- WOF = Width Of Fabric folded selvage to selvage
- All seam allowances are 1/4"
- Press fabric before cutting
- Cut and label all fabrics prior to sewing
- Finished size: 58" x 69"

Step 1: Cut and label all fabrics

Step 2: Blocks

- 1. Gather the A, B and C squares.
- 2. With a pencil or water soluble pen, draw diagonal lines onto the wrong side of a fabric 1 2" x 2" C and (3) 1½" x 1½" B squares.








- 3. Place the marked **C** square, wrong side up, onto the top right corner of a 5" x 5" A square and pin in place.
- 4. Sew on the marked line and trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance; flip/ press the C triangle out.








- 5. One at a time, sew and trim **B** squares on the three remaining corners of **A** to complete an ABC unit.
- 6. Repeat the steps for a total of (4) ABC units.




Make 4 ABC units

7. Sew the (4) ABC units together to make a Posie block.



Make a Posie block


8. Repeat with the remaining A, B and C squares for a total of (20) Posie blocks.




Make 20 Posie blocks

Step 3: Quilt Rows

1. To make a quilt row, sew (5) fabric 2 2½" x 9½" D strips and (4) Posie blocks; press to D.



2. Following the diagram below as a color placement guide to sew a total of (5) quilt rows with the Posie blocks and **D** strips.



Step 4: Sashing Rows

1. Sew (5) **fabric 3** 2½" x 2½" **E** squares and (4) **fabric 2** 2½" x 9½" **D** strips to make a sashing row; press to **E**.



2. Repeat for a total of (6) sashing rows.

Step 5: Quilt Assembly

- 1. Sew the (5) quilt rows and (6) sashing rows to make the quilt center; press seams to the sashing rows.
- 2. Sew (3) **fabric 2** 1½" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 1½" x 46½" **F** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges of the quilt center and press to **F**.
- 3. Sew the remaining (3) **fabric 2** 1½" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 1½" x 59½" **G** strips; sew onto the left and right edges of the quilt center and press to **G**.
- 4. Sew (3) **fabric 3** 2" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 48½" **H** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges of the quilt center and press to **F**.
- 5. Sew the remaining (3) **fabric 3** 2" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 62½" **I** strips; sew onto the left and right edges and press to **G**.
- 6. Sew (3) **fabric 4** 1½ x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 1½" x 51½" **J** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges of the quilt center and press to **J**.
- Sew the remaining (3) fabric
 4 1½ x WOF strips end to end
 and cut into (2) 1½" x 64½" K
 strips; sew onto the left and
 right and press to K.
- 8. Sew (3) **fabric 3** 3" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 53½" **L** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges and press to **J**.
- Sew the remaining (4) fabric
 3 3" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 69½" M strips; sew onto the left and right edges of the quilt center and press to K.

Step 6: Finishing

- Layer the quilt backing, batting and quilt top, and quilt as desired.
- Bind with the (7) fabric 4 2¹/₄
 x WOF binding strips, label and enjoy!
