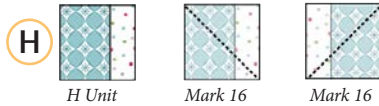


Oh Tannenbaum

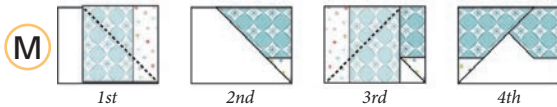
- Sew the (2) remaining **fabric 1** 2½" x WOF strips end to end and cut into (1) 2½" x 52½" **K** strip.



- With a pencil or water soluble marking pen, draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of (32) **H** units as follows:



- Follow the diagrams below to sew a marked **H** unit to the right edge of the 3½" x 4½" **M** strip and trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam allowance on the right edge of the sewn unit; press the triangle unit up.
- Repeat with a second marked **H** unit on the left edge of **M**.

3. From the leftover fabrics, cut (2) backing rectangles of matching fabric for each of the 24 ornaments and the tree star:

(8) pairs 6¼" x 4" - large ornaments
(6) pairs 5½" x 3½" - medium ornaments & star
(11) pairs 5" x 3¼" - small ornaments

4. Cut (25) batting squares as follows:

(8) 6½" x 7¼" - large ornaments
(6) 6" x 6½" - medium ornaments & star
(11) 5½" x 6" - small ornaments

5. Fold and press about 1¼" to the back one long edge of a backing piece, and stitch down with an ⅛" seam allowance.



6. With the backing piece with the fold on top and wrong side up, place the long edge of the unfolded backing piece, wrong side up about 1" below the fold and tape the two pieces together to hold in place.



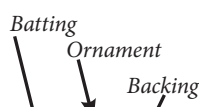
7. Trace the ornament template onto the wrong side of the taped backing pieces, centering the fold/overlap; cut the ornament out on the traced line.



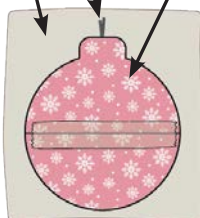
8. Place the applied ornament on top of the batting.



9. Now place the backing ornament on top of the applied ornament, right sides together and pin in place.



10. Sew the sandwich together with a ¼" seam allowance, trim the excess batting, remove the tape, clip the curves, and turn the ornament right-side-out.



11. Voila, you have a 3-D ornament. Repeat the steps with the remaining twenty three ornaments and the tree star.



Correction: follow steps 5-11 to assemble the ornaments.
