




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Features Cherry's Chalk Texture collection

- All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Press fabric before cutting
- Cut and label all fabrics prior to sewing
- Finished size: 79" x 79"

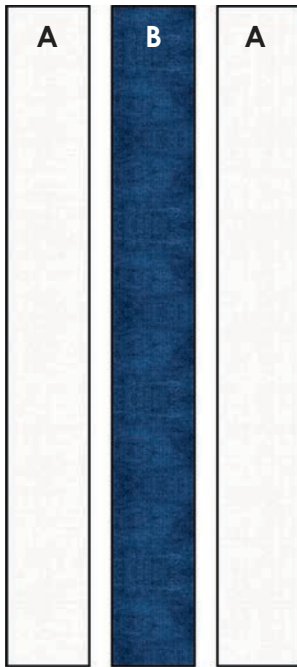
## Step 1: Cut and label all fabrics

	<b>Fabric 1</b>	White Loopy Daisy 9486-90	Blocks	(25) 2½" x WOF strips sub-cut into: (50) 2½" x 20½" - <b>A</b>  (37) 1½" x WOF strips - <b>S1 &amp; S2</b> (88) 1½" x 6½" - <b>S2</b> <i>Save the remaining strips for <b>S1</b> and <b>S2</b></i>	3 3/8 yds
	<b>Fabric 2</b>	Chalk Texture Cloud 9488-13	Border	(7) 1½" x WOF strips - <b>B1 &amp; B2</b>	1/3 yd
	<b>Fabric 3</b>	Chalk Texture Navy 9488-57	Border	(8) 3½" x WOF strips - <b>B3 &amp; B4</b>	7/8 yd
	<b>Fabric 4</b>	Chalk Texture Green 9488-44	Binding	(8) 2¼" x WOF strips - <b>Binding</b>	5/8 yd
	<b>Fabric 5</b>	Chalk Texture Light Royal 9488-53	Backing		5 yds

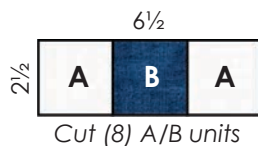
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## Step 2: Plus Sign Blocks

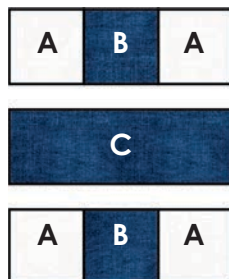
1. Sew a **fabric 1**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $20\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strip to the left and right edges of a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $20\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** strip; press to **B**.



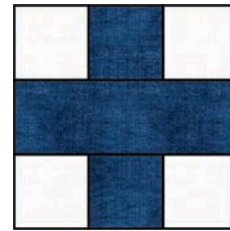
2. Cut the sewn strip into (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide **A/B** units; set aside.



3. To make a plus sign block, sew an **A/B** unit to the top and bottom edges of a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **C** strip; press to **C**.

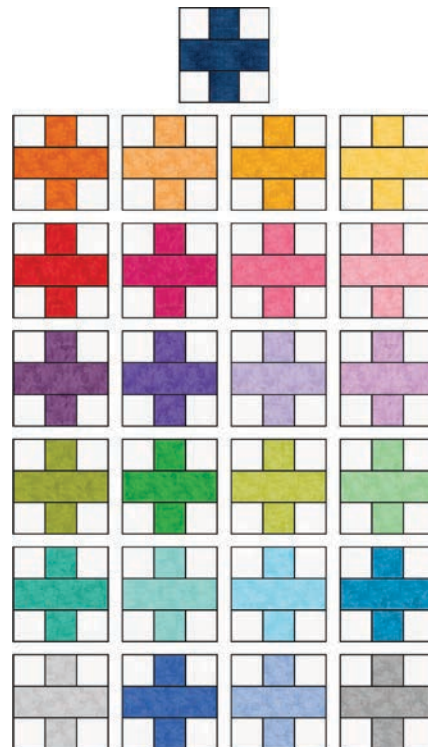


4. Repeat for a total of (4) plus sign blocks in the same color way.



Make (4) plus sign blocks

5. Repeat the previous steps with the remaining **B** & **C** strips and the **fabric 1** **A** strips; make (4) of each color for a total of (100) plus sign blocks.



Make 4 of each color for a total of  
100 nine-patch blocks



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## Step 3: The Quilt Center

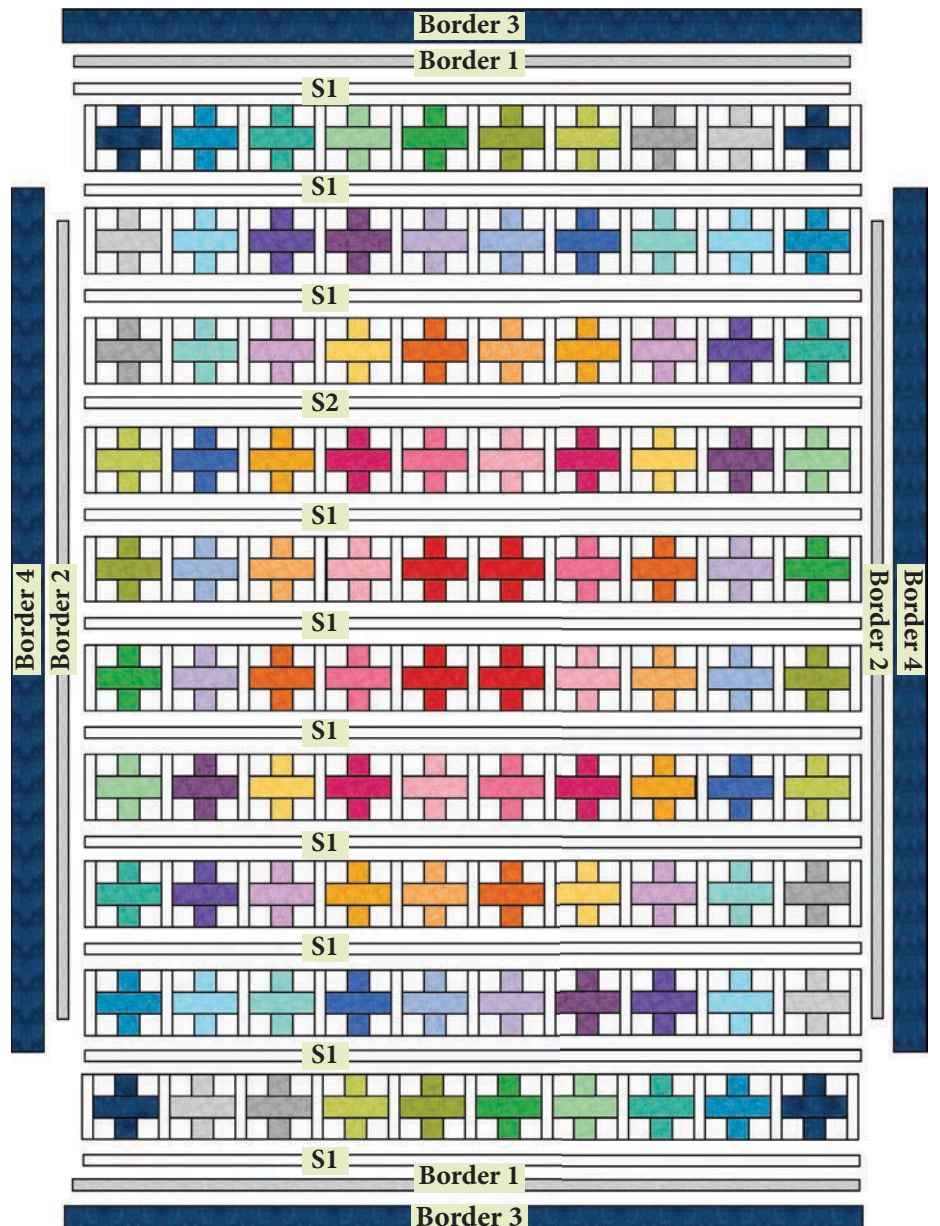
1. Follow the diagram below as a color placement guide to assemble the quilt center.
2. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **fabric 1** strips end to end can cut into (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $71\frac{1}{2}$ " **S1** sashing strip; repeat with (20)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **fabric 1** strips for a total of (11) **S1** sashing strips.
3. From the leftover strips cut (22)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **S2** sashing strips.
4. Sew (10) plus sign blocks and (11) **fabric 1**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **S2** strips to make a row; press to **fabric 1**.



5. Repeat for a total of (10) rows.

## Step 4: Assemble the Quilt Top

6. Sew the **S1** sashing strips sewn above in between the assembled rows to make the quilt center; press to **fabric 1**.
1. Sew (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **fabric 2** strips end to end can cut into (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $71\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 1** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges of the quilt center and press to **fabric 2**.
2. Sew all remaining **fabric 2**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips end to end can cut into (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $73\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 2** strips; sew onto the left and right edges and press to **fabric 2**.
3. Sew (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **fabric 3** strips end to end can cut into (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $73\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 3** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges of the quilt center and press to **fabric 3**.
4. Sew all remaining  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips end to end and cut into (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $79\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 4** strips; sew onto the left and right edges of the quilt center and press to **fabric 2**.



## Step 5: Finishing

1. Layer the quilt backing, batting and quilt top, and quilt as desired.
2. Bind with the (8) **fabric 4**  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF binding strips, label and enjoy!
